Humanist da'wah, as an approach that promotes and fights for the values of tolerance, justice, equality and concern for the well-being of humanity, gives rise to complex dynamics in its course (Fathulloh et al., 2023; Yulianto, 2020). In theoretical development, humanist da'wah involves a series of conceptual evolutions of various religious thinkers, intellectuals, and theorists who enrich and hone these concepts through broader philosophical, theological, and social studies. However, in its implementation, several challenges require careful handling and opportunities that can be utilized to create positive change. One of the main challenges in spreading the message of humanist da'wah is resistance to change. People often cling to traditions and norms ingrained in their culture for years, so they may not be in harmony with the essence and message carried by humanist da'wah. The cultural shift and change in the understanding of values require a long time and extra effort to overcome this resistance. Changes in culture are not always accepted quickly. Therefore, a thoughtful and patient approach is needed in spreading and practicing the message of humanist da'wah to gain wider acceptance and penetrate the layers of society. Sources that support the concept of humanist da'wah may be found in the works of Islamic thinkers who investigate universal values in religion, research that explores social and cultural dynamics, and the contributions of critical thinking on religion in forming a strong philosophical foundation for humanist da'wah.

In addition to resistance to change, the dynamics of divisions and conflicts that often arise between religions or between tribes often become significant obstacles in the implementation of humanist da'wah. This challenge often arises because of differences in beliefs, cultures, and complex histories, sometimes raising tensions between individuals or groups. Encouraging and fighting for tolerance and peace within such a complex framework requires a careful and sustainable approach. In the context of theoretical developments, humanist da'wah may manifest the contributions of thought from various schools of religious philosophy, social theories, and intercultural studies that involve critical thinking and in-depth analysis of issues of pluralism and social harmony. However, amid these challenges, humanist da'wah can utilize many opportunities. One of the most important opportunities is the apparent openness of the Muslim community towards interactive interreligious dialogue and more continuous interaction with non-Muslim communities. Globalization and technological advances have created tremendous opportunities to exchange views and ideas with diverse groups, which in turn can expand and enrich the understanding of human values embedded in the teachings of Islam. Sources that support the concept of humanist da'wah in response to divisions and conflicts between religions may be found in the works of cross-religious thinkers, research examining intercultural dialogue, and contributions from social literature in-depth in defining the principles of harmony among religious communities.

Another opportunity is the critical role of education in spreading the message of humanist da'wah. Schools, universities, and other educational institutions are places where human values can be instilled in the younger generation. An education-oriented humanist da'wah can help create individuals more concerned with social and humanitarian issues and more prepared to contribute to positive societal change. Furthermore, opportunities exist in interreligious partnerships and cooperation with humanitarian organizations. Humanist da'wah often intersects with the goals of these organizations, and collaboration can result in a more significant impact in addressing social and humanitarian issues.

It is essential to understand that the development of information technology and social media also play a significant role in spreading the message of da'wah (Ali & Budyastomo, 2021; Azlan et al., 2020). Social media and the internet provide a broad platform for individuals and groups who support humanist da'wah to communicate and share their notes. This is an excellent

opportunity to reach a wider audience and create awareness about the humanitarian message in Islam. However, there are also challenges associated with the use of social media. Fake news (hoaxes) and extremist messages can quickly spread through social media. Therefore, groups that support humanist da'wah must be careful in filtering the information they share and fighting misinformation.

Another opportunity is relations with international organizations and governments. Humanist da'wah, focused on global issues such as climate change, humanity, and world peace, can collaborate with international organizations to address these issues. The government can also be an essential partner in supporting humanist da'wah programs oriented to social and economic empowerment. However, amidst these opportunities, it is necessary to remember that the sustainability and success of humanist da'wah requires a long-term commitment. Social and cultural change does not happen overnight, and sustained effort is needed to achieve the goals of humanist da'wah. This requires the individuals and groups to maintain morale despite challenges and obstacles. Another challenge in the context of humanist da'wah is related to policy and law. Some societies have laws or rules that may conflict with the message of humanist proselytizing, such as laws governing gender issues or freedom of religion. To counter this, humanist da'wah activists must fight to change policies and regulations that do not support human values in Islam.

It is also essential to understand that Muslim societies have significant cultural, ethnic, and geographical diversity. The challenge in carrying out humanist da'wah is how to accommodate this diversity and adapt the message of da'wah so that it is relevant to various cultural contexts. A sensitive approach to culture and local context is essential in this case. However, diversity in Muslim societies also creates opportunities. This means that humanist proselytizing can be adapted to various cultural contexts and is better accepted in some communities than others. These opportunities allow the message of da'wah to reach different segments of the Muslim community with an approach that suits their values and needs.

Furthermore, it is essential to consider the role of women in humanist da'wah. Humanist proselytizing in favor of gender equality often faces resistance in societies with strong patriarchal norms. However, women can play a significant role in spreading the message of humanist da'wah and motivating social change. This is a considerable opportunity that needs to be taken advantage of. Another challenge that needs to be faced is political and social change in Muslim societies. Changes in leadership, policy, and political dynamics can affect the ability to spread the message of humanist da'wah. Therefore, individuals and groups supporting humanist da'wah need flexible strategies to adapt to these changes.

Challenges and opportunities in humanist da'wah must also consider the

role of civil society groups in supporting these efforts. Civil society organizations, including humanitarian groups, advocacy groups, and non-governmental organizations, can be powerful partners in promoting the message of humanist da'wah. They have expertise and experience in working on social and humanitarian issues and can provide practical support in carrying out humanist da'wah projects. However, the challenge in partnering with civil society groups is building trust and effective communication. Humanist da'wah should be able to clearly explain their goals and values to potential partners and ensure that the cooperation is mutually beneficial.

On the other hand, opportunities arise in the form of approaches that are based on data and evidence. Da'wah humanists can draw on research and data analysis to support their arguments about the positive impact of the humanitarian message in Islam. This can help prove that humanist proselytizing is a theoretical concept and has real benefits in improving social and humanitarian welfare. Another challenge that needs to be overcome is resistance to change in society. Societies often maintain established social norms and resist change, especially if the change is perceived as a threat to their identity or beliefs. Therefore, humanist da'wah must employ strategies that understand and respect the values that exist in society while gently introducing new concepts.

It is necessary to underline the importance of cooperation between religious and interfaith communities in promoting the message of humanity in Islam. This collaboration can create a space of optimistic and harmonious dialogue between different religious communities and beliefs, promoting peace, tolerance, and better understanding between religious communities. Opportunities exist for developing interfaith and interfaith dialogue initiatives that allow other parties to share their understanding of human values in Islam. Seminars, workshops, and dialogue forums effectively facilitate constructive communication among religious communities.

However, the challenge in this case is to overcome the disagreements and differences of views that may arise during the dialogue. In this dialogue, promoting a compassionate approach and an open attitude toward differences and upholding values such as respect and equality is essential. It is also necessary to recognize that humanist da'wah must constantly adapt to changing social and cultural developments. Societies change, and their views on human values can also evolve. Therefore, humanist da'wah must be flexible in the face of these changes and ensure that its message remains relevant in the context of the Times.

The challenge that needs to be overcome is understanding the development of society and adapting in a way that maintains the integrity of the da'wah message (Hamid & Uyuni, 2023; Shukri & Zain, 2020). Sometimes, too rapid or radical changes can generate resistance and disapproval in the community. Furthermore, humanist da'wah can motivate greater significant change in

Muslim societies. Through promoting human values in Islam, da'wah can encourage greater change in policies, laws, and social norms that support humanity. The challenge in this case is building political and social support for this change. Change often faces resistance from interested groups and requires careful efforts in mobilizing support and convincing community and political leaders to support the change.

In facing these challenges and taking advantage of these opportunities, long-term commitment, hard work, collaboration with various stakeholders, and the ability to adapt to change are essential. Humanist da'wah is a long journey that requires strong determination and patience, but the positive impact it can produce in Muslim societies and around the world is invaluable and has the potential to create significant change. Humanist da'wah has excellent potential to bring human values in Islam forward and play an essential role in creating a more tolerant, humane, and sustainable society.

D. CONCLUSION

The influence of humanist da'wah in pioneering social transformation and the dynamics of change in Muslim society has become a reality that has significant weight. The conceptualization of humanist da'wah as a paradigm that combines human values with essential principles in Islamic teachings has brought to life a more inclusive, tolerant, and humanitarian perspective in implementing religious practices. The development of theory in humanist da'wah may include contributions from various religious philosophers, humanitarian thinkers, and cultural researchers who reflect on and practice these principles about universal values and social sustainability. The impact produced by humanist da'wah in the Muslim community is reflected through changes in social behavior and the evolution of a more supportive, humanist mindset, and focused on helping those in need. This is a real foundation that provides evidence that the humanitarian message embedded in the teachings of Islam can be a source of inspiration for positive changes in the structure of society. Although challenges such as resistance to change, social polarization, and the spread of disinformation are things that must be overcome, there are various opportunities to spread the message of humanist da'wah through social inclusion, data-based approaches, and close synergies with various related entities. Collaboration between religious communities, educational institutions, religious leaders, and civil society organizations is crucial in supporting humanist da'wah efforts. To create a more tolerant, humane, and sustainable Muslim society, humanist da'wah carries great potential for realizing the human values that shape the future of progressive Islam.
